

Eligibility

Open to all junior golfers, boys and girls age 8 to 17, conforming to USGA standards for amateur status. Age status will be determined by the age of the child on the first day of competition, June 21st. The league will be limited to the first 120 paid entries. Junior golfers living outside Alamance County, NC may participate in the league if the field is not full at the deadline.

Entry Requirement

The Entry Fee is \$150.00 if received by 6:00 pm on Sunday, June 13th, 2010 All entries received after the deadline must pay a \$20.00 premium to enter the league (NO EXCEPTIONS) Players are encouraged to play in all of the events, but juniors may pick and choose any or all of the events to play in.

Format of League

The format of the league this year will be both individual and team based. Players will be drafted onto a team after the registration deadline. The number of teams will be determined by the number of participants registered. Each team will be assigned a coach and players must remain on that team for the season. Teams will compete each week based on how the individuals finish within their age groups. Teams will earn points each week and the team with the most points at the end of the season will win the League Championship. Juniors may also receive individual points for "Player of the Year" within their age groups. Awards will be presented at the banquet on Monday, August 9th
